Hello Everyone!

In Japan, December is called **Shiwasu**, which means teachers or priests run around. This word reflects the busiest month of the year. It's a Japanese custom to send **Oseibo** (end-of-year gifts) around this time of the year. Also it's customary to write and mail **Nengajo** (Japanese New Year's postcards) in December so that they are delivered on **Oshogatsu** (New Year's Day). During December, **Bonenkai** (forget the year gatherings) are held among co-workers or friends.

Christmas is not a national holiday in Japan, but people enjoy, no matter what is their religion, giving each other presents while towns are beautifully decorated with Christmas ornaments.

Osoji (extensive cleaning), is done before New Year's holiday, and Japanese New Year's decorations are usually placed around and inside the house. In Japan, New Year's Eve is called **Omisoka**.

Osechi ryori (Japanese New Year's Food) is eaten during the first three days of the New Year.

At midnight on New Year's Eve, all temples ring their bells 108 times, a tradition called **Joya-no-kane**. The year-end salutations are: "Kotoshi mo iroiro to osewa ni narimashita. Rainen mo yoroshiku onegai shimasu" (I thank you for all the favor towards me this year and look forward to next year). "Yoi otoshi wo omukae kudasai!" (Have a happy New Year!)

Illumination in Shibukawa (渋川 まちなかイルミネーション)

Ekimae Plaza and Ekimae-dori street in front of Shibukawa Station are decorated with colorful LED lights and creative displays made by students from Shibukawa City high schools, for the winter holiday season, and will be lighting up every evening between 5:00 pm and 10:00 pm, starting December 2 through January 31, 2024 (from 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm at the Yotsukado prefectural housing area).

An opening ceremony will be held at Ekimae Plaza on Saturday, December 2 from 5:00 pm to 6:30 pm.

Tori no Ichi Fair (哲の市)

Tori-no-Ichi (Bird Fairs or Rooster Festivals), take place on the days of the Rooster, at shrines throughout Japan, in November or in December. In Shibukawa, this fair is held from old times annually on December 16 at Yasaka Shrine, situated near Shinkoji Temple. Usually a forgotten silent shrine, on this day it is getting really crowded with people who come to pray for health, abundant harvest and prosperous business. At the Fair, open-air stalls line up selling kumade, good-luck rakes which are believed to "rake in good fortune" and bring happiness to those who purchase and display them throughout the years. Yasaka Shrine Omikoshi will be on display during the Tori-no-Ichi Fair. A big raffle drawing will also be held at the Fair.

Japanese Little New Year Decoration Workshop (小正角飾りづくり教室)

You will learn how to make a decoration with mayudama (cocoon-shaped rice cakes) and kakibana (long scratches from tree branches), used for Koshogatsu, Japanese Little New Year celebration.

Ikaho Ice Rink Now Open (伊香保リンクー 般開 放)



The Gunma Sports Complex Ikaho Rink is open for the season!

The 400-meter outdoor ice rink will stay open through Sunday, February 18, 2024 and the first indoor ice rink through Sunday, March 31, 2024 (except on Mondays, if it isn't a holiday, December 31, and January 1.) Gloves must be worn in the skate rink. Helmets, elbow and knee guards are free to rent. Bring your family, friends or come out yourself to Ikaho Ice Rink this winter.

Fee: Adults 1,250 yen, high school students and below 720 yen (after 5:00 pm, adults 930 yen, high school student and below 510 yen). It's free for preschoolers (they must be accompanied by an adult and must pay the skate rental fee). Skate rental is 320 yen (sizes from 15cm to 30cm).

Operating hours: 9:00 am to 4:45 pm (in March, from 11:00 am to 2:45 pm). Exclusive rink rental is available from 5:00 pm to 9:00 pm. The ice rink may not be available during tournaments or exclusive use, or may be closed at times due to weather conditions.
